CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19) FRANKLIN COUNTY UPDATE


For Immediate Release: January 8, 2021

Rocky Mount, Virginia – Today, the Virginia Department of Health (VDH) reports approximately **2,594** confirmed COVID cases in Franklin County. This is a <u>remarkable increase of **66** cases overnight, a new daily record.</u> The 7-day average number of new daily cases per 100,000 population reported is **58**, which is higher than the current state locality average. Since Thanksgiving, the County has seen an <u>increase of over **1,000** new cases</u> where the Virginia Department of Health (VDH) continues to advise Franklin County residents and businesses to adhere to wearing facial coverings or masks in public areas; exercise social distancing; and practice good hand hygiene. Taking actions both now and in the coming weeks is critical in slowing the spread of COVID-19.

With the recent significant increases of COVID positive cases in the local community and greater region, Franklin County expresses it is **vitally important** for area residents and visitors to continue to adhere to wearing facial
