For Immediate Release: August 6, 2021

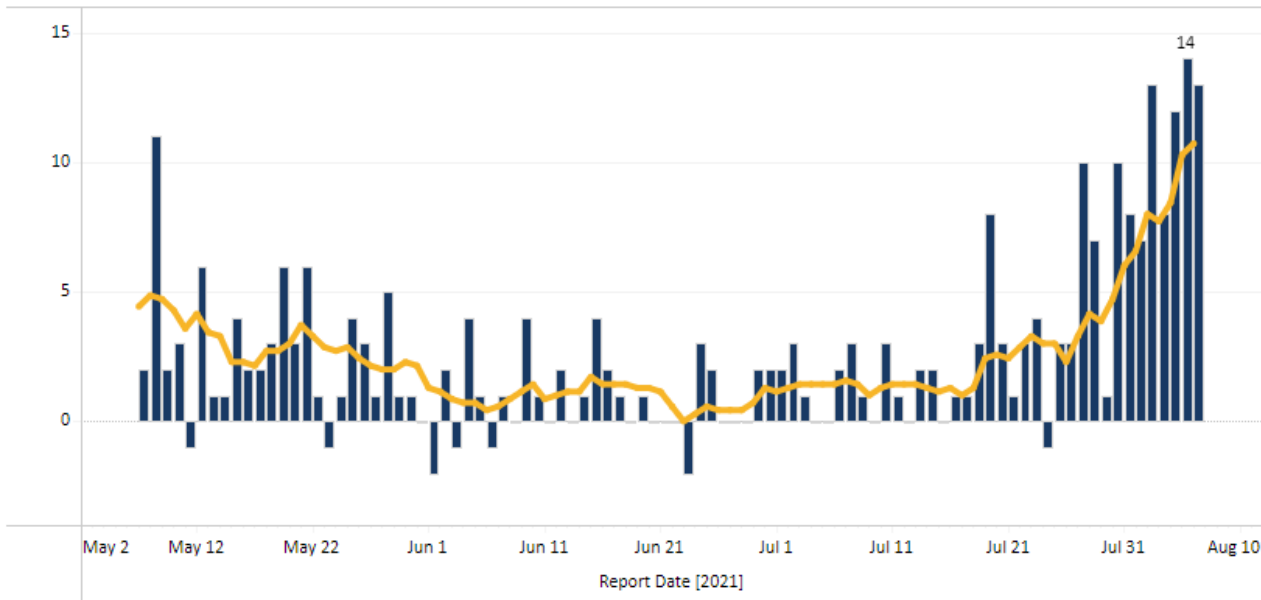
Rocky Mount, Virginia – Today, the Virginia Department of Health (VDH) reports approximately **13** reported new COVID cases in Franklin County overnight. The 7-day average number of new daily cases per 100,000 population reported is **19.1**.
